

Covid Protocols September, 2021

1. Skaters must arrive at the rink "ice ready" except for skates. The Township/Club will designate places to put on skates
2. Everyone must wear a mask upon entry to the arena and sanitize hands using the available sanitizing stations set up by the township.
3. Skaters do not need to wear a mask while on the ice.
4. Please stagger entry so physical distancing protocols can be met.
5. The township asks that we arrive not more than 15 minutes before the session begins
6. Screening protocols will be in place
7. There will be designated seating in the stands for parents, not surpassing occupancy limits set by the township.
8. We request that maximum 2 adults accompany a skater to help with keeping our numbers below the occupancy limits

Response for individual showing symptoms:

- If an individual becomes unwell with symptoms of COVID-19 they must immediately stop participation in club skating activities
- The individual will be isolated from all others in a well-ventilated area or outside and provided with a mask.
- The individual will be sent home and instructed to follow public health guidelines regarding self-isolation and testing
- The facility will be informed to determine if any areas need to be closed off or additional cleaning completed
- A member of the Skating Executive must be informed of the situation and will contact the individual or parent/guardian regarding next steps

COVID-19 testing:

- Any individual who is part of the club who has been tested for COVID-19 must not participate in skating activities while waiting for the results of the test.
- The club will consult with public health regarding the Session Participation tracking sheets to inform other members who might have been in close contact with the individual. Close contact is defined as within 2 metres for a period lasting more than 15 minutes, without appropriate use of PPE.
- If the COVID-19 test was negative, the individual may only return to skating activities once they no longer have any symptoms for at least 24 hours
- If the COVID-19 test was positive, the individual must follow all public health guidelines regarding return to activities.
